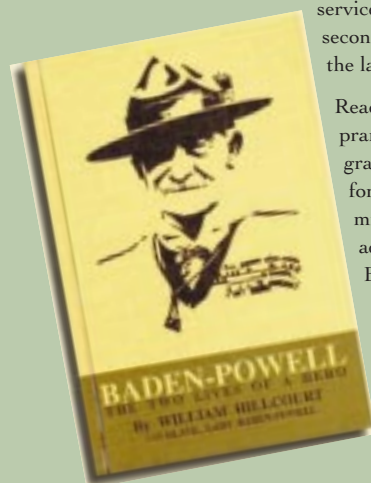

Readers of any age will be amused at B-P's boyhood pranks and freewheeling spirit. After failing to make the grade at his father's Alma Mater Oxford, he set off at 19 for India in Her Majesty's army. That began a stunning military career that lasted 34 years and brought him adventures throughout varied parts of the British Empire.

His career culminates during the Boer War (1899-1902), when he holds the besieged town of Mafeking, surrounded by an overwhelming enemy force for 217 days—the longest siege, up to that time, in history—by baffling the Boers with a string of innovative military tricks.

After the siege and back home in England, the feted "Hero of Mafeking" (at 43 the youngest general in the British Army), becomes concerned about the youth of Britain and decides to use his fame to help boys grow into strong manhood. He adapts his boyhood adventures and military skills into a scheme he calls "Scouting." In 1907, he tests it for a week in camp with 22 boys on Brownsea Island, and brings out his book describing his scheme, *SCOUTING FOR BOYS*, in 1908. Within a few years, Scouting blossoms into a worldwide movement, which B-P continued to inspire for the rest of his life. In 1941, at 83 years old, B-P dies in his beloved retirement home of Kenya, Africa.

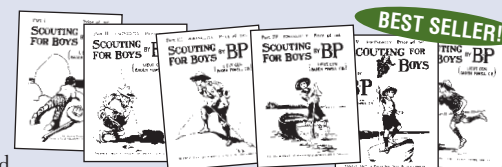
